## About us

BtH ISSG is recruiting a research intern for a duration of 3 to 6 months in the Terrorism, Conflict and War Directorate. This role is an excellent opportunity to develop your research skills and increase your area knowledge. Due to the pandemic, the internship will be remotely.

## Main tasks

- Collects and analyses data / information from a wide variety of sources to include local and global media, government and intergovernmental documents, academic journals, institutional databases, public conferences and seminars, publications of relevant civil society organisations and NGOs to compile weekly strategic events.
- Independently develops detailed weekly assessment that will outline the events and their impacts on the national/global scale and provides strategic foresight on the heading of the country.
- Prepares Crisis Horizon for Afghanistan on weekly basis.
- When/if necessary, details his/her analysis on a separate policy brief/food for thought paper.
- Contributes to the analyses and assessments of the MENA Task Force, reflecting impact from the perspective of Afghanistan ICCW BtH staff throughout the publication process.
- Presents findings in the form of a commentary, article, policy brief / recommendation, report or food for thought paper. The interns are expected to author at least one commentary per month and one research per quarter.
- Supports Crisis Horizon / Horizon Weekly in line with his/her focus area.
- Communicates and collaborates with internal / external researchers for joint products.
- o Contributes to the organization's outreach activities.



INFLUENCING AND PROMOTING GLOBAL PEACE AND SECURITY

- Supports daily management activities of BtH.
- In case an important development emerges in Afghanistan, the intern prepares an event concept in cooperation with Director, makes necessary preparation and conducts webinar.

- You have an excellent command of English, both orally and in writing; knowledge of Arabic is a plus.
