Beyond the Horizon International Strategic Studies Group (ISSG) is a non-partisan, independent, and non-profit think & do tank. The mission of Beyond the Horizon ISSG is to promote global peace and security by empowering decision and policymakers with knowledge and advocating paths to prevent, mitigate or end crises and conflicts.

Beyond the Horizon ISSG is unique in its focus on realistic policies and in-depth analyses to offer comprehensive solutions on topics related to international politics and security, peace and conflict studies.

BtH ISSG's funding comes from a variety of sources, mainly research grants, public procurement, but also from membership and conference fees.

BtH ISSG is recruiting a research intern for a duration of 3 to 6 months in the Terrorism, Conflict and War Directorate. This role is an excellent opportunity to develop your research skills and increase your area knowledge. Due to the pandemic, the internship will be remotely.

Ideal starting date: May 2021

Main tasks

- Collects and analyses data / information from a wide variety of sources to include local and global media, government and intergovernmental documents, academic journals, institutional databases, public conferences and seminars, publications of relevant civil society organisations and NGOs to contribute to MENA TF Briefs, specifically reflecting country of interest perspective.
- Based on the geostrategic context, outlines how the country of interest and actors involved in it will be affected and how they have potential to affect the progression of events to provide strategic foresight on the subject.
- When/if necessary, details his/her analysis on a separate policy brief, food for thought paper, commentary, article, report etc.
- Communicates and collaborates with internal / external researchers for joint products.
- Contributes to the organization's outreach activities.
- Supports daily management activities of BtH.
- In case an important development emerges in the country of interest, the intern prepares an online event concept / webinar in cooperation with Director, makes necessary preparation and conducts it.

Tasks will be modified/finalized after the interview with the candidates.
